

Here is a prayer for each day during Lent. These prayers were composed by Nancy and Sue and attached to a doll.

1. We pray for all victims of human trafficking. We ask You to destroy this modern form of slavery. Jesus save these victims and set them free from the terror in which they are held captive.
2. We pray that judges will receive training about human trafficking and there will be greater justice for victims with more prosecutions of traffickers.
3. We pray for parents/grandparents to warn their children about the signs of human trafficking.
4. We pray that victims will receive forgiveness, unconditional love, and acceptance from all as they heal from the trauma of their slavery.
5. We pray for families who may believe their child is delinquent, rebellious, or a runaway when in fact they are a human trafficking victim. We pray for reconciliation between parent and child.
6. God, enter into the lives of victims through other people and bring Your healing.
7. You're a God of miracles. You are the Healer, Restorer, and Life Giver. We pray that the victims will know Your Presence with them. We ask for Your power to give them hope that they will be set free from their captivity.
8. God, You restore the years the locusts have eaten. We pray that the victims will find new life, purpose and joy.
9. Holy God, we ask for Your power to destroy the chain of supply and demand that perpetuates evil bondage to pornography, and the buying of sex.
10. We pray for safe places-treatment centres for victims, to be established in every province.
11. Dear God, grant each one in slavery the hope that every tear will be wiped away and every injustice made right.
12. We pray that police will receive training about human trafficking and be vigilant in arresting traffickers.
13. We ask God that You remove the sin that blinds the traffickers, opening their eyes to the evil they commit and leading their hearts to repentance.
14. We pray for those enslaved by greed and cruelty. Heavenly Father, convict the hearts of abusers to the sickness of lust and greed.
15. We pray for all politicians at all levels of government to be engaged in the fight to end trafficking, hate evil and establish justice.
16. We pray that government will stand on the side of victims. Turn the hearts of leaders to enact laws to protect the vulnerable.
17. Pray against poverty where often trafficking begins. Empower the poor so that they can be released from the chains of poverty.
18. Father grant a way for people to care for their families so girls and boys are not at risk or vulnerable. Guard over their activities on the internet.
19. We pray for committed workers who will be steadfast in the fight to do everything possible to eradicate human trafficking
20. Show us the truth that human trafficking occurs not only overseas, but also in our city, and can happen to anyone and show us what we can do.
21. Open the doors so that the school system and organizations that serve youth will fight for education and prevention. Raise up your people to take risks so others can be saved.

22. You are a God of freedom. Raise up an army of people willing to take action so that sexual exploitation will come to an end.
23. Open our eyes that we may see the signs/red flags of victims and know the vulnerability/risks of potential victims so that we can preserve, defend and save the innocent.
24. Open our hearts and give us courage to be bold and steadfast in effecting change in our longing for justice and peace.
25. Bless those who work to end human trafficking at local and international levels. Shine your light of justice and love on the darkest corners of the world to give hope.
26. Keep our spirits passionate and give us a righteous anger to fight for the dignity and rights of those trafficked and violated through threats, deception and force.
27. We cry out against sexual exploitation and pray for it to end. Strengthen the victims' fragile spirits and heal their brokenness.
28. We pray the victims will be rescued and reunited with their families.
29. We pray for all whose bodies and spirits are abused and broken, for all who long for freedom. We pray for their complete physical, mental and spiritual wholeness.
30. We pray that the police services continue the fight to end sexual exploitation and that they will find themselves in the right place and time to apprehend abusers and save victims
31. Help us to remember the steps to make victims safe: PREVENTION, PROTECTION AND PROSECUTION
32. Comfort your rescued children. Enable them to feel safe and begin to heal. Protect them from those who seek to continue to harm them.
33. Dear Lord, we know only You can bring joy and hope where only shame and fear exist. We pray for those children who need to know that they can be made whole again.
34. Dear Lord, give strength to those who investigate and prosecute traffickers. Encourage them when they are weary. Help them to persevere.
35. Dear Lord, provide children affected by horrors of trafficking and exploitation with safe shelter, food, compassion and love.
36. Dear Lord, surround these tortured young souls with Your love and acceptance hiding them firmly in the palm of Your hand.
37. Remind the victims always-that none of this was their fault. Teach us all to defend the rights of others.
38. Guide the doctors, nurses, and counsellors to provide compassion, understanding and acceptance. Help them to listen with all their strength to the victims and have the courage to report suspected incidents.
39. Remind us always to respect the dignity of every human being. We are all worthy of love.
40. Show us Your will and give us Your strength to fight for justice and freedom always choosing good over evil.
